

## Three of a Kind

You will need to enter **a set of three separate prints or images**. The idea is to show a related set, or panel of images, so a group of three good pictures should beat an unrelated group of three stunning ones. Thus the best sets won't necessarily be pictures that would stand alone as good images. The judge will be asked to view the prints side by side as a panel. For the digital images he will need to view them in sequence. You will need to label the prints/images slightly differently - with numbers 1 to 3 instead of just 1 and 2. Prints & images will then be displayed in the order 1 (left), 2 (centre), 3 (right).

Since the format is different to our normal competitions you may use any images, regardless of whether or not they have previously been entered into any SPS competition, but not used in a previous 3 Of A Kind Competition. The maximum entry is 1 set of 3 images for each of the 2 sections.
